Note: FOC (First Class Operators CW Operators' Club) has a coinciding event. It is not widely publicized -- not included on general contest calendars -- because it is essentially a members-only contest. Members apparently prefer NOT to have QSOs with non-members because the contacts are not counted for credit. Although, if hard-pressed -- just to be kind (?) -- they can enter a QSO with a non-member using 0000 as the other operator's # but trading on CW might be cumbersome. Just FYI. FOC event CQers might not want to QSO with non-FOC members.
